The web portal (Figure 1, top) is organised around five tabs:

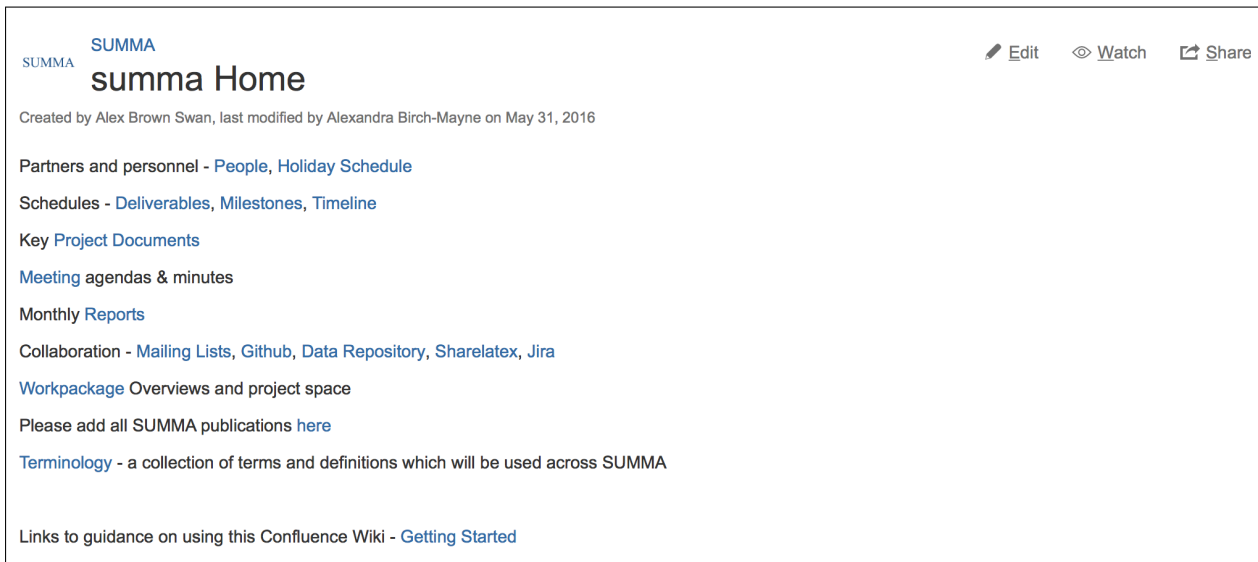
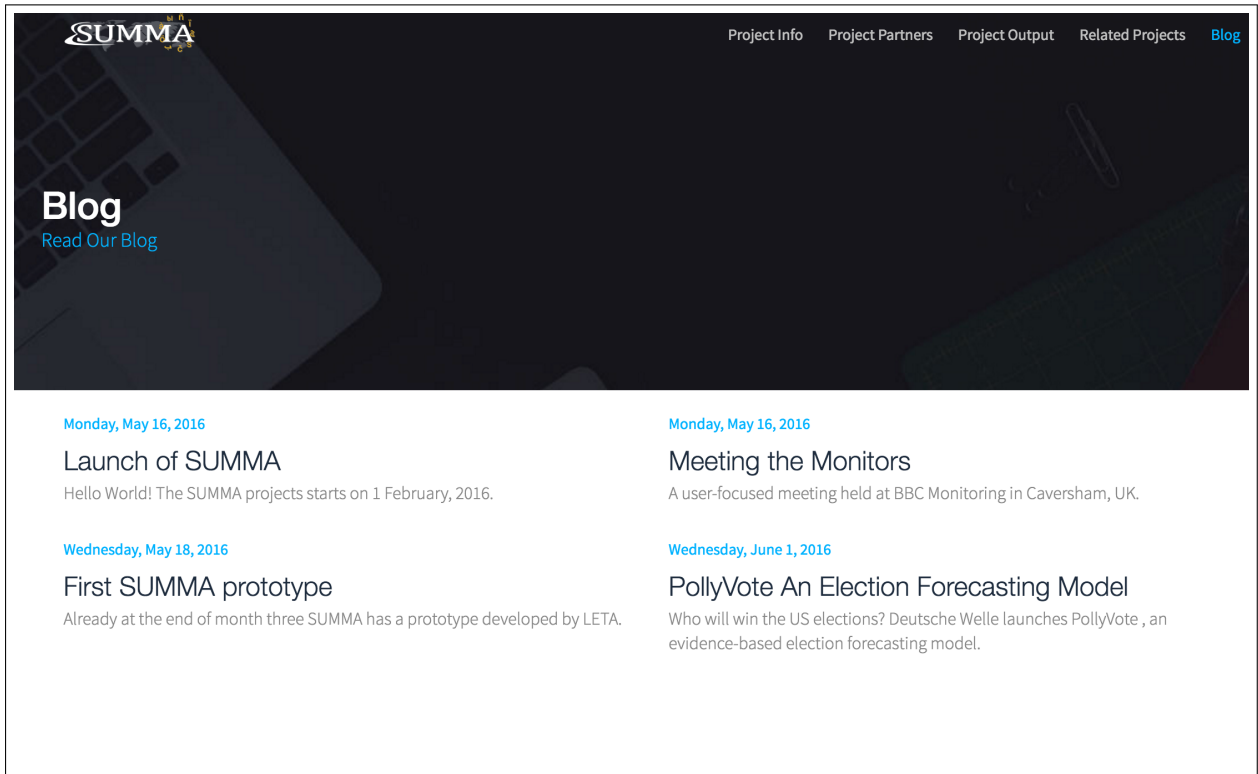
- Project info: including the project goals, use case descriptions, and an overview of the workplan.
- Project partners: descriptions of the consortium partners, together with brief bios of individuals involved with the project.
- Project outputs: links to project deliverables and publications to be (included via OpenAIRE), as well as links to demos and prototype systems.
- Related projects: links to EU, national, regional, and international projects related to SUMMA.
- Blog: a series of blog posts written by project participants, relating to the project.

## 3 Internal website

In addition to the external facing website we have an internal web platform based on Confluence (wiki), JIRA (issue tracking and project management), Box (shared data), and Github (shared repositories). These systems have over 70 registered users from the project partners, and are extensively used. The lower part of Figure 1 shows the wiki home screen.

## 4 Conclusion

The SUMMA website is now live at <http://summa-project.eu>. Content is being added, and we shall make a public launch of the project website in early July 2016. Content will continue to be added throughout the project, and the website will continue for at least ten years after the end of SUMMA.
